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

Personalized Intervention Plans



Site-wide Implementation Plan

Tailor implementation to the real world conditions facing your students, staff, and school with this collaborative fill-in-the-blanks template. The site-wide plan can be saved, so when staff turns over, new teachers get quickly up to speed. At the end of the year, teachers or schools can evaluate the implementation by referring back to original goals and examining measures of success or progress, as well as decide on necessary adjustments based on changing circumstances.



Pounce

Record and reinforce targeted student behaviors and skill building with this observational tool. *Pounce* makes it easy for all staff to focus on positive behavior and share reports with students and families to recognize and discuss student growth, or as part of future planning.



Assessment (Individual, continued)

Screen for Strengths

Identify strengths and opportunities for growth, and monitor progress toward targeted social-emotional competencies with this student self-report tool. Screen for Strengths aids educators in directing students to personalized, targeted interventions and reduces legal exposure possibly due to subjective, culturally biased assessment.

Group Seeing I to I

Identify potential trouble spots and build positive school climate with survey tool. Separate online surveys capture student, staff and parent perspectives of bias. The surveys focus on three areas related to respect: perceived adult behavior toward diverse groups, perceived student behavior toward diverse groups and personal attitudes about diversity.



Program management tools

Individual

Administrator's can manage individual educator's viewing and editing privileges to support student privacy.

Group

Educators can upload lists of student information from a spreadsheet with the "Import" feature. The "Groups" feature then allows users to organize student names into lists.
